**Public Forum Debate.**



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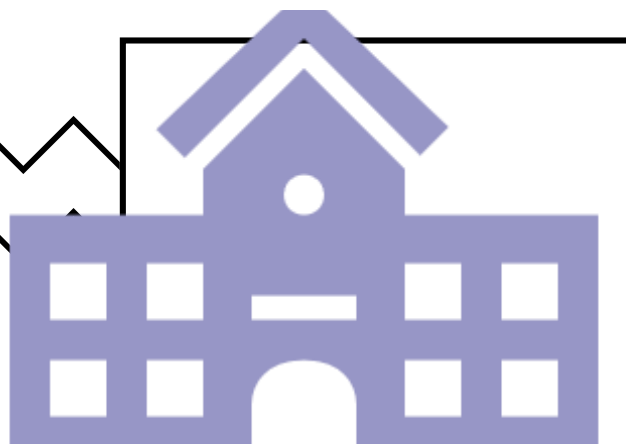
# THE PROJECT

- O4: to increase participants' English and IT skills communication and digital competence



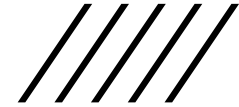


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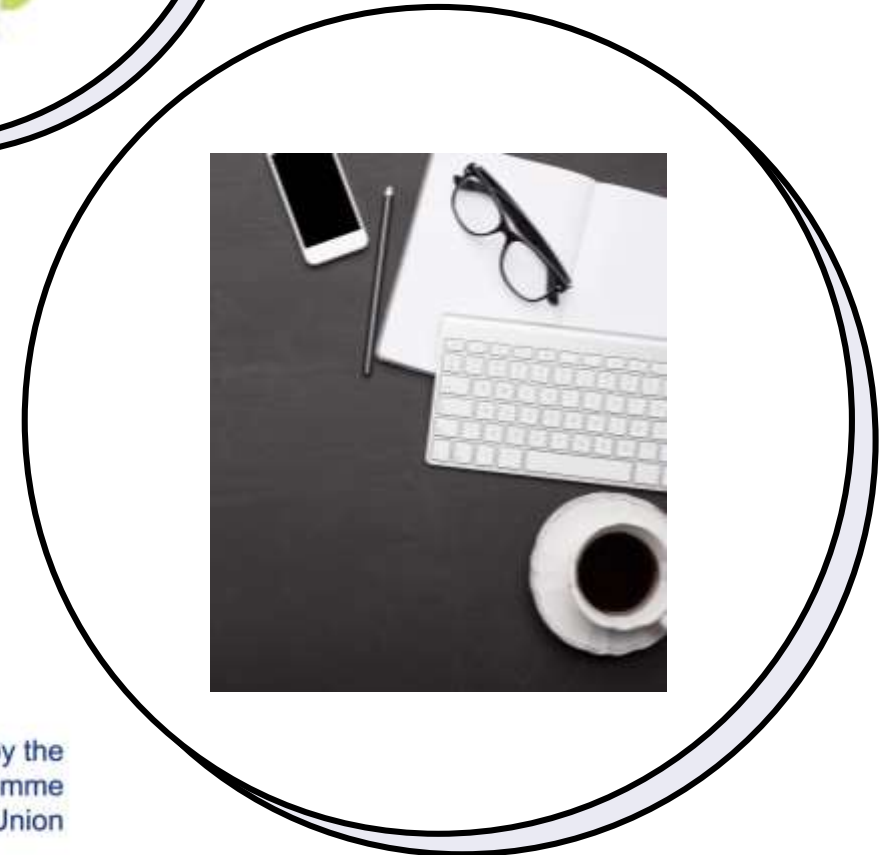

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# IMPLEMENTATION



- Founding 5 junior debate clubs in 5 partner schools;
- 5 international Public Forum competitions in 5 European countries promoting 5 common European values
- 10 activities to promote civic engagement, cultural heritage: tangible ( monuments, works of art), intangible (traditions, crafts):
- 5 events to promote inclusion of disadvantaged groups (national/ethnic minorities, immigrants) and equality for all citizens;
- 5 workshops to train teachers to innovate using debate in classroom /clubs

- R2: Methodological guide to implement debate;
- R3: Five Public Forum clubs;
- R4: A multilingual debate glossary;
- R5: eTwinning site - debate, inclusion resources ;
- R6: Aproject magazine Outcomes:

- R8: Participants' enhanced debate and learning skills ;
- R 9: Innovator teachers- competences in debate methododology;
- R10: TG's increased inclusive attitudes ;

11: Participants' improved English and digital skills
